Based on the inquiries made on our own supplier base regarding the use of Conflict Materials, we have no reason to believe that any of the conflict materials have been intentionally added to our suppliers' products.

At Nitronica Limited we recognize our responsibility not to support or contribute to the violence and human rights violations associated with the mining in central Africa of certain minerals that are essential to the performance of today's electronics.

At Nitronica Limited we fully understand the importance of this issue to our customers and are committed to supply chain initiatives and overall corporate social responsibility and sustainability efforts that work towards a conflict free supply chain.
